Three bank accounts following sale of Old Hall for £74,000.

Money Market Interest (Main Account) by now there is £96,274 in this account. There was £19 in another account which works and links to the main account (set up that interest being transferred from one account to another).

National Savings (Post Office) £3800

Following a successful application for part funding from Cadwyn Clwyd for a feasibility study another £4500 is outstanding, Meeting attendees suggested asking for funding from Brenig Windmill also Cambwl Windmill Fund and also possibly using the money from the National Savings Account.

Finances

Documents continue to be with the Auditors – no correspondence received by them even after Clerk sent a message. Clerk required the return of cheque book to pay £40 ICO, £700 Clerk, £144 J Llywelyn Hughes, £23.99 Fasthost. The Community Target for the Denbigh Urdd Eisteddfod has been reached. Councillors agreed £50 as Chair's allowance.

Precept – it was agreed to increase the present by £2. During 2019-20 £2901 received. 'Taxbase' is 166 in 2020/21 therefore £332 increase – total of £3233 annum. Request for donation by Cylch Meithrin Gwyddelwern was discussed. Councillors decided they will discuss 2020/21 spending during their next meeting as all the paperwork are with the Auditors.
